This funding will be used to:

Improve the literacy achievement of students – specifically Reading and Writing – of all students in English.

- Increase upper 20% year 3 to Year 5 NAPLAN relative gain in Reading and Writing.
- Increase % year 3 and 5 students at and above NMS (National Minimum Standard)
- Increase % year 3 and 5 students in U2B (Upper 2 Bands) for Reading and Writing.
- Semester 2 English C or better % of Prep to Year 6 student from 2019 – 2020

Promote and embed school wide high expectations for behaviour and student self regulation.

- Increase % of students receiving CLIMB (Collaborator, Learner, I own my learning, Meaning Maker and Bridge Builder) acknowledgment.

Our initiatives include:

In 2020 Manly West State School will continue to focus on the four key priorities as outlined in our Annual Implementation Plan:

- Grow a Reading Culture that creates expert and engaged young readers;
 - Embed core pedagogical practices for strong curriculum alignment
- Create digitally savvy learners;
 - Embed Critical and Creative thinking across all areas of the curriculum with a focus on “Making Thinking Visible”.
- Grow a collaborative, connected community of learners; and
 - Enact a whole school approach to student well-being including social/emotional regulation, Bridge Builders and CLIMB.
- Excellent practice is the standard practice at Manly West State School
 - Continue the development of collective teacher efficacy; coaching and feedback; knowledge and use of data.

Our school will improve student outcomes by:

- Building capacity and providing time for teachers to analyse and inform teaching, learning and resourcing, and to track and monitor progress, using Early Start materials, PM and Probe benchmarking, the P-10 Literacy Continuum and PAT – Progressive Assessment Testing (\$53000).
- Provide support for all students from at-risk to gifted through student based collaborative enquiry supported by strongly aligned curriculum planning and support (\$68200).
- Continue to implement school programs and resourcing including Bridge Builders, Reading2Learn, STEM, Probe, PM (\$22800)
- Professional Development for new staff in Reading2Learn (\$2800)
